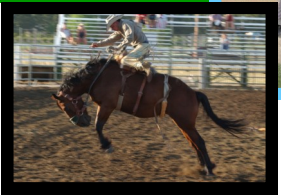


Destination Dickinson, ND

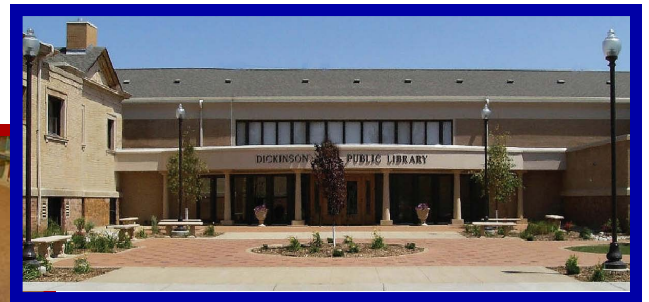


The West River Community Center measuring 93,000 square feet is the envy of all North Dakota indoor recreation centers with an

- The Community of Dickinson recognizes the value of family and social life. Broad based support for community initiatives has resulted in development of facilities and events that keep life fun and interesting.

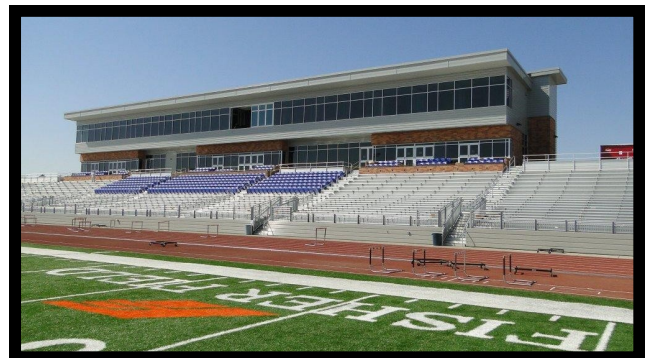


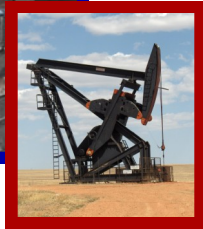
- Burlington Northern Santa Fe's main line runs east/west through Dickinson offering rail access carrying many different commodities daily.



- The Dickinson Theodore Roosevelt Regional Airport serves over 10,000 passengers a year with 3 daily flights available and accommodates private aircraft.

- The Badlands Activity Center is a recently built \$16 million Regional use Facility capable of hosting many different kinds of events seating more than 3,500 fans and offering 5,500 square feet of multipurpose space. The Center was supported and funded by the Community and was designed to accommodate 3 home teams.





- The Dickinson area has one of the nation's strongest economies due to our diverse economy of agriculture, energy (coal, ethanol, natural gas, oil, uranium) national and international manufacturing, and tourism.



- Regional Medical Center for Southwest North Dakota featuring a Hospital, 2 General Clinics and many Specialty Clinics with future plans for a new hospital & medical complex.

- Dickinson is home to Dickinson State University which is a 4 year College. DSU has nationally recognized sports programs with a growing enrollment of students representing 26 Countries (including 5 Canadian Provinces) and 40 States.
