





What is Single Stream Recycling?


Single-stream recycling refers to a system in which all recyclables (paper fibers, plastics, metals, and other containers) are mixed in a collection truck, instead of being sorted into separate commodities (newspaper, paperboard, corrugated fiberboard, plastic, glass, etc.) and handled separately throughout the collection process.

In single-stream, both the collection and processing systems are designed to handle this fully commingled mixture of recyclables, with materials being separated for reuse at a materials recovery facility (MRF).

Everyone is doing it, so why is recycling so difficult in North Dakota?

Where can we take the materials we collect?

Search area for a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) 550 mile radius of Dickinson



There are seven (10) MRFs in 500 miles of Dickinson:

1-SD

2-Canada

5-MN

2-CO

Transportation cost is an issue the City needs to address

5 Stages of Recycling

- 1. Collection (City-Single Stream Recycling)
- 2. Sorting (*MRF)
- 3. Washing/Cleaning
- 4. Reclamation (Shredding, grinding, classifying, etc.)
- 5. Extruding (melting)

North Dakota is missing steps 2-5 statewide
