

STARK COUNTY AREA PROFILE

Stark County's 2019 resident population was 31,489, a one-year numeric change of +596 or a change of +1.9 percent. The unemployment rate for Stark County in May 2020 was 11.3 percent. One year prior, the unemployment rate was 1.7 percent. There were 343 job openings in Stark County in June 2020. On average in Q4 (Oct-Dec) 2019, the private industry in Stark County employing the largest number of workers was Mining, Quarrying, and Oil and Gas Extraction.
